AGREEMENT FOR FIBER OPTIC NETWORK LEASE

BACKGROUND

- A. Sacramento Public Library Authority (Authority) desires to use the City's fiber optic network to connect their district offices and main campus to the Natomas Library.
- B. The proposed interagency agreement will allow the Authority to use approximately 142,764 feet of the City's existing fiber conduit for an annual maintenance and lease rate of \$0.05 per lineal foot, or approximately \$7,138.20 per year.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Agreement with the Sacramento Public Library Authority for the lease of fiber on the City's fiber optic network is approved and the City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute the Agreement.


