

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-693

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

November 3, 2009

MOU WITH ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, FIREARMS AND EXPLOSIVES

BACKGROUND

- A. The California Emergency Management Services' Project Safe Neighborhood/Anti Gang Initiative Program provides funding to local law enforcement agencies for public safety purposes. The Sacramento Police Department used this funding to purchase ballistics analysis equipment.
- B. In order to partner with and operate the ballistics system, a memorandum of understanding with The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives is required. The MOU will allow SPD to collect images of ballistic evidence and test fires of firearms taken into law enforcement custody and enter these images into the NIBIN System for analysis.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to enter into a memorandum of understanding with The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) for the purpose of collecting images of ballistic evidence and test fires of firearms taken into law enforcement custody and entering these images into the NIBIN System for analysis.


