PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH WEST YOST ASSOCIATES

BACKGROUND

- A. The Water Supply Master Plan identifies the infrastructure required to continue providing reliable water service to City customers.
- B. The General Plan Utilities Implementation Program, policy U 2.1.5 requires the Utilities Department to update its water master plan every five years. The last update was performed in 2005.
- C. West Yost Associates has been selected through a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) process to provide engineering services to update the Water Supply Master Plan.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to sign a Professional Services Agreement with West Yost Associates for the Water Supply Master Plan update for an amount not to exceed \$420,348.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to transfer \$170,000 of water funds (Fund 6005) from the Lower American River Study Program Fund (Z14009100) to this project fund (Z14000500).


