APPROVE REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH THE DOWNTOWN SACRAMENTO PARTNERSHIP FOR DOWNTOWN COMMUNITY PROSECUTION PROGRAM SERVICES

BACKGROUND

- A. The City Council approved the establishment of a Downtown Community Prosecution Program in 2006 to facilitate cooperative efforts for prosecution of city code violations within certain geographic boundaries in the downtown including Old Sacramento.
- B. A collaborative partnership including the Downtown Partnership, Regional Transit, and the City of Sacramento provides funding for the Community Prosecution Program.
- C. The program has proven to be successful in reducing crime and increasing prosecution using the authority of the District Attorney's Office to solve problems, provide public safety and enhance the downtown area.
- D. The program supports the efforts of public safety and economic development to revitalize the downtown area.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute a Reimbursement Agreement with the Downtown Sacramento Partnership to provide Community Prosecution Program Services in the downtown area for a one year term with option to renew for up to three additional years.
