ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (Cal EMA) FOR THE GANG VIOLENCE SUPPRESSION (GVS) MULTI-COMPONENT PROGRAM Fiscal Year (FY)2009/10

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento has been designated to receive a grant award of \$350,000 through the State of California Emergency Management Agency (Cal EMA) to fund the Gang Violence Suppression (GVS) Multi-Component Program, to run from July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010.
- B. The City of Sacramento's award is \$350,000. The City of Sacramento Police Department (SPD) and its partner agencies will share the cost of the required 10 percent match of \$35,000. The SPD will receive \$71,112 with a match of \$7,111 for sworn labor (detective salary and benefits) to pay 60 percent of an existing 1.0 Full Time Equivalent (FTE). The City's portion of the 10 percent match will be \$7,111, which will be paid out of an existing SPD operating budget. The remaining \$40,657 of a Police Detective's salary and benefits of \$118,880 will be paid from the City's General Fund. If grant funding is discontinued the position and associated budgets will be eliminated.
- C. This funding will maintain a collaborative effort among the SPD, Sacramento County Probation Department, Sacramento County District Attorney's Office, Sacramento City Unified School District and two community based organizations, La Familia and Another Choice, Another Chance, to identify gang members, suppress gang activity, and present gang-awareness-training-in-feeder-and-attendance-areas-of-Hiram-Johnson-High-School, Luther Burbank High School and C.K. McClatchy High School.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1 The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized on behalf of the City of Sacramento to accept \$350,000 in grant funding from the State of California Emergency Management Agency (Cal EMA) for the Gang Violence Suppression (GVS) Multi-Component Program FY2009/10, including any future extensions, agreements, modifications, or attachments thereof.
- Section 2 The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to establish a grant project for the Gang Violence Suppression (GVS) Multi-Component Program FY2009/10.
- Section 3 The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to make the necessary grant and operating revenue and expense budget adjustments to implement the \$350,000 grant award.


