

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-008

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

January 7, 2010

PURCHASE OF DETECTABLE WARNING TILES

BACKGROUND

- A. Pursuant to Federal Law, CFR28, Part 36, Appendix A, ADA Accessibility Guidelines (ADAAG), 4.7.7., the Department of Transportation has a requirement for the purchase of detectable warning tiles and;
- B. Staff requests that the City Council accept the results of Bid No. B10131061007 and award a one-year purchase agreement to River City Building Supply, in the amount of \$133,241, with two optional one-year extensions. The total amount of the agreement, with optional extensions, is not to exceed \$399,723.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The results of Bid No. B10131061007 are hereby accepted for the purchase of detectable warning tiles and;
- Section 2. The Procurement Division is authorized to execute a one-year purchase agreement with River City Building Supply for an amount not to exceed \$133,241 for the purchase of detectable warning tiles, and optionally extend the agreement for up to two additional one-year periods, with the total amount of the agreement including the optional two one-year extensions not to exceed \$399,723.


