FISCAL YEAR (FY)2008/09 CITIZEN'S OPTION FOR PUBLIC SAFETY

BACKGROUND

- A. The State Citizen's Option for Public Safety (COPS) Program provides funding to local City and County law enforcement agencies for public safety purposes.
- B. The State of California originally allocated the City of Sacramento \$758,573 in FY2008/09 COPS grant funding.
- C. On June 9, 2009 City Council approved Resolution Number 2009-371 authorizing the City Manager to accept \$758,573 in COPS grant funding and increasing the Police Department's Grant Operating and Grant Revenue budgets.
- D. On July 29, 2009, the State of California sent notification to the City that FY2008/09 COPS funding will be reduced by \$487,224 to \$271,349.
- E. City Council Resolution 2009-406 (Section 9) requires City Council approval for any increase or decrease greater than \$100,000 to grant funded projects.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or designated representative, is authorized to make the necessary grant revenue and expense budget adjustments to reduce FY2008/09 COPS grant funding by \$487,224.


