**SACRAMENTO RIVER WATER TREATMENT PLANT (SRWTP) FLOW METER
INSTALLATION PROJECT (Z14007200)**

BACKGROUND

- A. The Sacramento River Water Treatment Plant (SRWTP) Flow Meter Installation Project (Z14007200) will help ensure a safe and reliable water supply by providing better tools to operate the Sacramento River Water Treatment Plant. This project will install an 18 inch flow meter on the filter wash water pipeline and a 42 inch flow meter on the existing 42 inch discharge pipeline leaving the plant.
- B. City staff prepared a set of plans and specifications for the project and the project was advertised for bidding, with bids received on January 6, 2010.
- C. Koch Excavating, Inc was the lowest responsible bidder.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The contract plans and specifications for the Sacramento River Water Treatment Plant (SRWTP) Flow Meter Installation Project (Z14007200) are approved, and the contract is awarded to Koch Excavating, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$127,550.


