### **MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT: STATE LEGISLATIVE ADVOCACY FOR SACRAMENTO AREA WATER COALITION**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. In order to protect the water supply interests of the region it is important to have a consistent and effective advocacy at the State Capitol.
- B. Staff for the City and five other local water agencies (San Juan Water District, Sacramento Suburban Water District, Placer County Water Agency, and the cities of Roseville and Folsom) have developed a proposed Memorandum of Agreement for cost-sharing the services of a legislative advocate to promote their common interests regarding water rights and water supply.
- C. Under the proposed Memorandum of Agreement, the San Juan Water District will be responsible for hiring Fernandez Government Solutions as a legislative advocate to represent the interests of the region before the State Legislature. Each agency's cost share for this one year contract will be \$16,000.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Agreement Regarding State Legislative Advocacy with San Juan Water District, Sacramento Suburban Water District, Placer County Water Agency, and the cities of Roseville and Folsom.


