

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2010-072**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

February 16, 2010

### **YOUTH AND FAMILY SERVICES PROGRAM**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The Office of Youth Development is working in partnership with the Sacramento Redevelopment Housing Agency (SHRA) to support a Youth and Family Services Program to offer opportunities, serve and activities that promote healthy development of children, youth and families within qualified multi-family housing communities.
- B. The three main components of the Youth and Family Services Program are: Site Specific Initiatives based on specific programs, projects and activities at specific sites, Youth and Family Initiatives which are community-based organizations and partnerships that promote youth and family and Citywide Support Initiatives that have citywide community impact.
- C. These program strategies will be funded by the Multi-Family Supplemental Annual Administrative fees. The fees currently generate approximately \$430,000.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. Establishment of a multi-year project for the Youth and Family Services Program (102000300).
- Section 2. Resolution 2009-604 is amended as stated in Section 1.


