

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-100

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

February 23, 2010

ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS FOR THE SACRAMENTO SAFE COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP

BACKGROUND:

- A. Sacramento Safe Community Partnership, a collaborative effort between the Sacramento Police Department, the City's Office of Youth Development, County Probation, Parole, the District Attorney's office, Sacramento Employment and Training Agency (SETA), Sacramento City Unified School District, as well as community-based and faith-based organizations, recognized a need to deal with youth violence in the City of Sacramento by implementing an evidence based program based on the ceasefire model.
- B. In September 2009, the United States Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention granted the City of Sacramento \$200,000 for Safe Community Partnership.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1 The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to accept a grant award, on behalf of the City of Sacramento, from the United States Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention which totals \$200,000.
- Section 2 The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to establish a grant project for \$200,000 grant award.
- Section 3 The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to increase the Police Department's grant operating and revenue budgets in the amount of \$200,000.


