

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-120

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

March 9, 2010

AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF CITIES OF SERVICE LEADERSHIP GRANT (G01000100)

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento was one of 50 cities nationwide to apply for the Rockefeller Foundation's Cities of Service Leadership grant.
- B. The Cities of Service has approved a grant to the City of Sacramento for \$200,000 to hire a Chief Service Officer dedicated to developing and implementing a citywide plan to increase volunteerism and targeting volunteers to address the city's greatest needs.
- C. The grant funding can only be used to pay for personnel costs of the Chief Service Officer. The program does not require matching funds and will not impact the General Fund.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to accept, on behalf of the City of Sacramento, \$200,000, in grant funding from the Rockefeller Foundation.
- Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to establish the Cities of Service Leadership Grant (G01000100) project.
- Section 3. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to establish a \$200,000 revenue and expenditure budget in G01000100, in the Operating Grants Fund (Fund 2702).
- Section 4. The Mayor's office staffing is hereby increased by one full time equivalent (FTE) position, Special Assistant to the Mayor. This position will be established as a limited term position for the duration of the grant and will terminate when grant funding is no longer available.


