

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-133

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

March 16, 2010

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH CONTRA COSTA YOUTH COUNCIL TO ALLOW THE CITY TO PROVIDE STAFFING AND MANAGEMENT SERVICES AT THE CCYC'S CAMP NEJEDLY DURING THE SUMMER OF 2010

BACKGROUND

- A. The Contra Costa Youth Council has asked the Parks and Recreation Department's Access Leisure section to operate its summer wilderness camp for teens with disabilities at Camp Nejedly for two weeks in the summer of 2010.
- B. Contra Costa Youth Council will reimburse the City for costs up to \$78,816, therefore, no General Fund support is necessary.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute an agreement and any amendments thereto with Contra Costa Youth Council for the City to provide staffing and camp management services for a wilderness camp at Camp Nejedly during the summer of 2010.


