AWARD A CONTRACT FOR FAIRBAIRN WTP DRINKING WATER RESIDUAL SOLIDS DEWATERING PROJECT

BACKGROUND

- A. The volume of residual solids collected annually at the Fairbairn Water Treatment Plant (WTP) exceeds the plant's storage and air drying capacity.
- B. City staff proposes that the City contract with a specialty dewatering firm. The project was advertised for bidding and bids were received on March 10, 2010. P&H Senesac, Inc. was the lowest responsible bidder.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The contract for Fairbairn WTP Drinking Water Residual Solids Dewatering is awarded to P&H Senesac, Inc., for an amount not to exceed \$249,536.


