



Resolution

Recognizing National Public Works Week May 16-22, 2010

WHEREAS, public works services provided in our community are an integral part of our citizens' everyday lives; and

WHEREAS, the support of an understanding and informed citizenry is vital to the efficient delivery and operation of public works systems and programs, such as solid waste collection and disposal, neighborhood traffic management, recycling, parking, traffic operations, street maintenance, engineering, architecture, animal care, urban forestry and fleet and facility maintenance; and


