

# RESOLUTION NO. 2010-277

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

May 25, 2010

## AGREEMENTS FOR HIGH SPEED INTERCITY PASSENGER RAIL (HSIPR) AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT (ARRA) FUNDS

### BACKGROUND

- A. The project will relocate the existing UPRR mainline tracks, build new passenger platforms and access tunnels, relocate existing utilities, and install new utilities.
- B. The project was awarded a \$6.2 million grant of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funds as part of the High Speed Intercity Passenger Rail (HSIPR) program administered by the FRA. These funds will pass through Caltrans to the City. FRA will enter into agreement with Caltrans and Caltrans and the City will enter into a sub-recipient agreement.

### BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute funding agreements with Caltrans and take other actions related to accepting High Speed Intercity Passenger Rail (HSIPR) funds for the Track Relocation Project (T15092000/ T15029006)
- Section 2. The project revenue and expenditure budgets are increased by \$6,200,000 (Fund 3703) to reflect the federal ARRA HSIPR Rail funds (T15029000/T15029006).
- Section 3. Exhibit A is incorporated into and made part of this resolution.




