

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-281

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

May 25, 2010

CAPITOL / L ALLEY SEWER AND WATER REPLACEMENT, 17TH TO 18TH ST. (X14010050)

BACKGROUND

- A. The combined sewer system pipeline and water main in the alley between Capitol Ave and L Street from 17th to 18th Street are in poor condition and in need of replacement.
- B. City staff prepared the plans and contract specifications to replace approximately 380 linear feet of combined sewer pipeline, including sewer services, manholes and drain inlets, and to replace approximately 380 linear feet of water main, including gate valves, fire hydrants and water services to improve these facilities and public safety. The project was advertised and ten (10) bids were received on April 21, 2010.
- C. The lowest bid was submitted by Martin General Engineering, Inc.; however, Martin General Engineering's bid failed to list a subcontractor for an item of work exceeding ½ of one percent of the bid amount, and Martin General Engineering has confirmed that this work must be performed by a subcontractor. Failure to list a subcontractor for this work is a violation of the California subcontractor listing law. For this reason, the bid submitted by Martin General Engineering was nonresponsive and is rejected.
- D. Biondi Paving, Inc. was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The plans and specifications for the Capitol / L Alley Sewer & Water Replacement, 17th to 18th St. (X14010050) are approved, and the contract is awarded to Biondi Paving, Inc., for an amount not to exceed \$186,679.


