**FREMONT AREA SEWER REHABILITATION – PHASE 2
(X14010039)**

BACKGROUND

- A. The Department of Utilities has identified the combined sewer pipelines within the Fremont Area to be in poor condition with a history of failure and in need of rehabilitation. The project has been designated as the second of four phases to repair approximately 2690 linear feet of combined sewer pipelines within the Fremont area by lining them with a cured-in-place-pipe (CIPP) liner.
- B. City staff prepared the plans and contract specifications to rehabilitate the identified sewer pipelines and manholes to improve these facilities and public safety. The project was advertised and three (3) bids were received on April 28, 2010. PIPEnergy, Inc. was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The plans and specifications for the Fremont Area Sewer Rehabilitation – Phase 2 (X14010039) are approved, and the contract is awarded to PIPEnergy, Inc., for an amount not to exceed \$405,250.




