Recognizing the 60th Anniversary of the Macedonia Baptist Church of Del Paso Heights

WHEREAS, the Macedonia Baptist Church of Del Paso Heights began its life on the first Sunday in July, 1950, with a group of seven organizers under the leadership of Reverend C. M. Cummings; and

WHEREAS, the following year a small sanctuary was built on Benton Street to serve the Church's growing congregation; and


WHEREAS, the congregation and the Church's facilities continued to expand throughout the next three decades, merging with the Truevine Baptist Church in 1973, and establishing the sanctuary it occupies today in 1988; and

WHEREAS, throughout its six decades, the Macedonia Baptist Church has been active in the community of Del Paso Heights, serving the needy and the homeless, ministering to the elderly and infirm, tending and educating the community's youth, and sponsoring programs such as a Prison Outreach Ministry and Young Men's Training Center; and


WHEREAS, the Church has remained steadfastly dedicated to its mission and vision to serve those in need through fellowship, outreach, and evangelism.




STEVE COHN, DISTRICT THREE








