APPROPRIATION OF TRAFFIC CONGESTION RELIEF FUNDS

BACKGROUND

- A. The City received funding for fiscal year 2009/10 under the State Traffic Congestion Relief program. Eligible uses are maintenance, reconstruction, and storm damage repair.
- B. To receive Traffic Congestion Relief (AB2928) funds, the City of Sacramento is required to annually expend, from its General Fund for street, road, and highway maintenance purposes, an amount not less than the annual average of its roadway maintenance expenditures from its General Fund during the fiscal years 1996/97, 1997/98 and 1998/99. Traffic Congestion Relief (AB2928) defines General Fund as any unrestricted funds that the local jurisdiction may expend at its discretion, including vehicle in-lieu tax revenues, revenues from fines, and forfeitures expended for street and highway purposes. The City of Sacramento has met the annual required expenditure of \$147,000.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The FY09/10 CIP is amended by appropriating \$1,183,249 from the Traffic Congestion Relief (AB2928) - Maintenance of Effort Program (Fund 2009) to the Overlays and Seals Program (R15072000).


