AWARDING CONTRACTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF SWIMMING POOL CHEMICALS

BACKGROUND

- A. The Parks and Recreation Department has an on-going need to purchase a variety of chemicals required to operate and maintain the City's swimming pools, wading pools and fountains.
- B. On April 8, 2010, the Department of Parks and Recreation, in accordance with City Code Section 3.56, issued Invitation for Bid No. B10190015212 for the purchase of five groups of chemicals. Eight responses were received, although not all respondents provided bids for all five groups.
- C. The lowest responsive and responsible bidder for Groups I and II was determined to be Lincoln Equipment, Inc., with a total bid for Fiscal Year (FY) 2010/11 of \$305,990. .

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. A one-year contract is awarded to Lincoln Equipment, Inc., for the purchase of chemicals in an amount not to exceed \$305,990 for Fiscal Year (FY) 2010/11.
- Section 2. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute the contracts and the required purchase orders for FY2010/11.


