

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-443

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

July 27, 2010

CONTRACT: COVER THE KIDS PROGRAM: CHILD ACTION, INC.

BACKGROUND

- A. The Department of Parks and Recreation has operated the City's Cover the Kids (CTK), Sacramento Children's Health Initiative since 1998 successfully assisting more than 34,000 children access affordable health care. Since late 2005, CTK, through funds awarded from the First 5 Sacramento Commission, has subcontracted with Child Action, Inc. to expand services into preschools throughout Sacramento County.
- B. In April of 2010, the First 5 Sacramento Commission accepted the new proposal submitted by CTK for a three-year grant to provide outreach, enrollment, retention and utilization services to families with children up to age six. CTK will subcontract with Child Action, Inc. in order to continue to provide services for the FY2010/11, FY2011/12, and FY2012/13 as outlined in the scope of work in an amount not to exceed \$232,624.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or a designated representative, is authorized to execute a three-year professional services agreement and any amendments related thereto with Child Action, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$232,624 for a three-year period to provide outreach, enrollment, retention and utilization of health care services to children up to age six.




