

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-448

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

July 27, 2010

ESTABLISHING THE STREETCAR PLANNING STUDY PROJECT, AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF FUNDING AGREEMENT, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS

BACKGROUND

- A. As part of the 2010 federal and state programming, the Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) awarded a grant in the amount of \$310,000 in federal funds to the City for a Streetcar Planning Study. This grant requires \$90,000 in matching funds and the source of local match is (Fund 2001) the Major Streets Improvement project.
- B. The City of Sacramento applied for these funds in order to perform a planning study that would evaluate the feasibility of alternative streetcar routes throughout strategic locations in the City.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Streetcar Planning Study project (T15115800) is established as a new Capital Improvement Program.
2. The FY10/11 Capital Improvement Program is amended by appropriating federal grant funds in the amount of \$310,000 to the Streetcar Planning Study Project (T15115800), and \$90,000 (Fund 2001) for local match is transferred to the Streetcar Planning Study Project (T15115800) from the Major Streets Improvement Project (T151080000).
3. The City Manager is authorized to execute a Program Supplement with Caltrans.


