Title: 2010 City Street Overlay Project (R15072019)

Location/Council District: Various streets in Council Districts 4, 7, and 8. Location map – Exhibit B of Resolution.

Recommendation: Adopt a **Resolution:** 1) approving Plans and Specifications for the 2010 City Street Overlay Project (R15072019); 2) awarding the contract to Granite Construction Company for an amount not to exceed \$835,678; and 3) authorizing the City Manager to sign the contract.

Description/Analysis

Issue: The 2010 City Street Overlay Project (R15072019) was advertised and bids were received on June 16, 2010. Granite Construction Company is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder (see Attachment 1). City Council approval is necessary to move forward with awarding a construction contract.

Policy Considerations: The action requested herein is consistent with the Sacramento City Code, Title 3 and with the City of Sacramento Strategic Plan goals of achieving sustainability and improving and expanding public safety.

Environmental Considerations:

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA): The Community Development Department, Environmental Planning Services Division has reviewed this project and determined that it is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Class 1, Section 15301(c).

Projects exempted under Class 1, Section 15301(c) consist of the operation, repair or minor alteration to existing highways and streets, sidewalks, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities.

Sustainability Considerations: This project is consistent with the City's Sustainability Master Plan. It conforms to the Air Quality Focus Area by improving and optimizing transportation infrastructure. The project will use Rubberized Asphalt Concrete. Approximately 12,494 recycled tires are to be used as part of this project.


Commission/Committee Action: None.

Rationale for Recommendation: Granite Construction Company is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

Financial Considerations: The 2010 City Street Overlay Project (R15072019) has a total budget of \$1,167,284 consisting of local (Gas Tax) and state (AB2928 and Proposition 1B) transportation funds. As of July 11, 2010, the 2010 City Street Overlay Project (R15072019) has an unobligated balance of \$1,031,159, which is sufficient to execute the contract with Granite Construction Company in the amount of \$835,678 and cover construction management costs. There are no general funds planned or allocated for this project.

The approval of this project will support 23 jobs in the City of Sacramento based upon the model provided by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) of one new job for every \$35,000 of transportation project investment.

Emerging Small Business Development (ESBD): The City's ESBE goal is 20%. To encourage small and emerging business participation, plans and specifications were sent to 19 plan rooms and construction service organizations for publication. All are directly involved with ESBE construction firms. The project was also announced on the City's Project Internet site at www.cityofsacramento.org/bids. Granite Construction Company's certified ESBE participation is 20.4%.



Background Information:

The 2010 City Street Overlay Project (R15072019) is an annual preventative maintenance program that extends the life of City streets and reduces the need for costly road reconstruction projects. Rubberized Asphalt Concrete overlays are being used to reduce noise and to extend pavement life. Approximately 12,494 tires are to be recycled as part of this project.

This project was advertised and four bids were received on June 16, 2010. The bids are summarized below:

Contractor	Bid Amount	ESBE Participation (Goal 20%)	Responsive
Granite Construction Company	\$835,678	20.4%	Yes
Desilva Gates Construction	\$878,577	20.7%	Yes
Teichert Construction	\$918,423	22.0%	Yes
Delta Construction	\$1,040,224	100%	Yes

The engineer's construction estimate was \$1,100,000. It is recommended that the Contract be awarded to Granite Construction Company for its lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Construction is anticipated to start in August 2010 and be completed in October 2010.


