A RESOLUTION TO APPOINT REPRESENTATIVES TO THE SACRAMENTO GROUNDWATER AUTHORITY (SGA)

BACKGROUND

- A. On August 11, 1998, the City Council approved a Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) that created the Sacramento North Area Groundwater Management Authority, subsequently renamed the SGA.
- B. The JPA requires that the City Council appoint representatives to the SGA Board of Directors from the City, California American Water, Del Paso Manor Water District, Golden State Water Company, Natomas Central Mutual Water Company, Sacramento Suburban Water District, and self-supplied users.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby appoints the following representatives to the Sacramento Groundwater Authority Board of Directors:
