### **DISSOLUTION OF THE MEADOWVIEW DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. In 1992, the City Council of Sacramento established the Meadowview Community Action Committee;
- B. In 1996, the Meadowview Community Action Committee was renamed to the Meadowview Development Committee
- C. The role of the Meadowview Development Committee was to advise the City of Sacramento and the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency on the planning and implementation of community development improvements in Meadowview through the allocation of Community Development Block Grant funds and other financial resources; and
- D. The Meadowview Development Committee has inspired broader community mobilization in the community.
- E. The proposed action does not constitute a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) per Guidelines Section 15378 (b) (2), NEPA does not apply.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The statements above, including the environmental statement, are found to be true and correct.
- Section 2. The City Council dissolves the Meadowview Development Committee.


