

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-478

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

August 10, 2010

ESTABLISH A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE AN INDIVIDUAL PROJECT AGREEMENT; APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS

BACKGROUND

- A. Since 1992 the City of Sacramento has utilized the Problem Alley Abatement Program as a remedy to deter public nuisances such as illegal dumping, theft and other criminal acts within the public alleyways.
- B. On July 13, 2010 the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency approved a Resolution for the South Oak Park Alley Assessment Action Plan which allowed the amending of the 2010 Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency budget by defunding \$75,000 from the Stockton Boulevard West 9/10th Avenue project and reallocating the funds to the South Oak Park Alley Abatement Project.
- C. The Oak Park Redevelopment Plan seeks to improve the neighborhood environment and image, eliminate blighting conditions and provide appropriate amenities to support the basic residential character of the area.
- D. The South Oak Park Alley Abatement Project is consistent with the Oak Park Five-Year Implementation Plan (2009-2014) which includes the strategies of Corridor Development and Enhancement and Strengthen the Residential Neighborhoods.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The South Oak Park Alley Abatement Project (T15115100) is established as a new Capital Improvement Project (CIP).
- Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to enter into Individual Project Agreements with the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency in the amount of \$75,000 for the South Oak Park Alley Abatement Project (T15115100).
- Section 3. The FY10/11 Capital Improvement Program is amended by appropriating \$75,000 (Fund 3701) of the South Oak Park Alley Abatement Project (T15115100).


