

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-519

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

August 31, 2010

APPROVING AN AGREEMENT FOR EVIDENCE IMPOUND VEHICLE STORAGE SERVICES

BACKGROUND

- A. The Police Department must ensure the secure and safe storage of all vehicles that are evidence or contain evidence as part of a crime. This agreement is a necessary means to maintain the chain of custody on all evidence recovered from the vehicles in question.
- B. Procurement Services issued an Invitation for Bid No. B10131061016 for Evidence Impound Vehicle Storage Services. A total of 3 bids were received. Shanahan's Towing was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Shanahan's Towing for evidence impound vehicle storage services for one (1) year with up to four (4) one-year renewal options, not to exceed \$57,760 each year for the first two years and not to exceed a total of \$295,825 for the total maximum agreement term of five (5) years. The City Manager, or his designee, may authorize the renewals, provided that sufficient funds are available in the budget adopted for the applicable Fiscal Year(s).


