POSITION ON THE NOVEMBER 2, 2010 STATE GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT

BACKGROUND

- A. The State of California will hold a General Election Ballot on November 2, 2010.
- B. Proposition 23 is one of ten Propositions to be considered by California voters on November 2, 2010.
- C. The balance of the propositions will be heard by the Law & Legislation Committee on September 7, 2010, and forwarded to the full City Council for consideration thereafter.
- D. The City of Sacramento Law and Legislation Committee reviewed Proposition 23 on August 5, 2010.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Council takes an oppose position on Proposition 23, the California Jobs Initiative.


