Recognizing Land Park Pacific Little League All Star Championship

WHEREAS, in 2010, Land Park, Pacific Little League reached the All Star Championship for the 2010 Little League Season; and

WHEREAS, three baseball divisions brought home District 7 Championship Banners; a repeat of the previous 2009 season; and

WHEREAS, this feat has not been accomplished since the creation of Land Park Pacific Little League in 1994; and

WHEREAS, this Little League is one of the oldest Little Leagues in the Sacramento area, established as Land Park Pacific in 1994 by combining Land Park Little League (established in 1954) and Pacific Little League (established 1959); and


WHEREAS, currently there are over 500 individuals in the Land Park Pacific Little League and it continues to grow in numbers while many other area Little Leagues decline in size; and

WHEREAS, Land Park Pacific plays on picturesque Dooley Fields established in 1958, and redone in 2008 for the 2009 season; and




