

## RESOLUTION NO. 2010-553

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

September 21, 2010

### APPROVING THE USE OF A COOPERATIVE PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF AN AUTOMATED MATERIALS HANDLING SYSTEM FOR THE NORTH NATOMAS LIBRARY (B13000700)

#### BACKGROUND

- A. The North Natomas Library project is partially funded by State Library Grant funds in the amount of \$7,013,889. In order for the City to receive the full grant funding, the grant requires that the library include the installation of an automated materials handling system (AMHS).
- B. In April 2008, the Sacramento Public Library Authority (Library Authority) issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for an AMHS for the four new libraries (Elk Grove, North Natomas, Valley Hi-North Laguna, and Pocket-Greenhaven) scheduled to open in 2010. A total of five firms responded to the RFP. A selection committee was established by the Library Authority to review the proposals and make a recommendation. Envisionware, Inc. was selected as the most qualified firm.
- C. On July 24, 2008, the Governing Board of the Library Authority adopted Resolution No. 08-44, approving a contract with Envisionware, Inc. and stipulating that member jurisdictions and partner Library agencies may use the contract to purchase AMHS equipment.
- D. In accordance with Sacramento City Code section 3.56.240, the City Manager may, by cooperative purchasing agreements approved by City Council, purchase supplies or nonprofessional services through contracts of other governmental jurisdictions without separate competitive bidding where it is advantageous to the City.

#### BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The use of the Sacramento Public Library Authority cooperative purchase agreement with Envisionware, Inc. for the purchase and installation of an AMHS for the North Natomas Library is approved.
- Section 2. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute the purchase under the above cooperative purchase agreement in an amount not to exceed \$488,027.




