ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDING FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE FOR THE COLD CASE JUSTICE PROJECT

BACKGROUND

A. The City of Sacramento has been awarded a \$100,000 in congressionally selected grant funding through the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance for the FY10 Cold Case Justice Project.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to accept, on behalf of the City of Sacramento, \$100,000 in grant funding through the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance for the Cold Case Justice Project.
- Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to establish a grant project for the FY10 Cold Case Justice Project Grant (#G11008200).
- Section 3. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to increase the Police Department's grant expense and revenue budgets by \$100,000 to implement the Cold Case Justice Project Grant.




