

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-636

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

November 9, 2010

GRANT: CALIFORNIA TASK FORCE SEVEN (CA TF-7), URBAN SEARCH AND RESCUE (US&R) TEAM HURRICANE EARL BLUE INCIDENT SUPPORT TEAM (IST) DEPLOYMENT (G12702200)

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento Fire Department has been the sponsoring agency for CA TF-7 US&R team since the inception of the Federal Urban Search & Rescue program in the early 1990's. CA TF-7 has responded for emergency assistance to the bombing of the Federal Murrah building in Oklahoma City, the terrorist attack of the World Trade Center in New York, to the Gulf Coast in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina and various other events.
- B. CA TF-7 can be deployed as an entire team, or individual Incident Support Team (IST) members, to provide overhead support to man-made and natural disasters; and national special security events.
- C. On September 1, 2010, a CA TF-7's Blue IST team member was activated by the Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency (DHS/FEMA) for deployment to Hurricane Earl.
- D. To receive reimbursement for costs associated with the deployment activities for the Hurricane Earl Blue IST deployment, the City must adopt a resolution granting signature authority for the City Manager to sign the DHS/FEMA Assistance Award/Amendment EMW-2008-CA-1498, Amendment M013.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute the agreement (EMW-2008-CA-1498, Amendment M013, which attached as Exhibit A and made a part of this Resolution) to accept the federal funding for CA TF-7 US&R Team in the amount of \$14,000.
- Section 2. An operating grant shall be established for the CA TF-7 US&R Hurricane Earl Blue IST Deployment (G12702200).
- Section 3. A revenue and expenditure budget in the amount of \$14,000 shall be established for the CA TF-7 US&R Hurricane Earl Blue IST Deployment (G12702200).


