APPROVING FUND TRANSFER TO THE NORWOOD AVENUE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT (T15068400)

BACKGROUND

- A. The project will replace the structurally deficient Norwood Avenue Bridge over Arcade Creek with a new bridge that meets current standards. The project will construct a new and higher concrete bridge with two travel lanes, bike lanes, sidewalks, and street lighting and a new approach roadway between the intersections of Fairbanks Avenue and Lindley Way. A new traffic signal will be constructed at the intersection of Norwood Avenue and Fairbanks Avenue. Retaining walls will be constructed on both approaches in order to support the increase in profile grade.
- B. The bridge was constructed in 1945 and is rated structurally deficient. Arcade Creek has a history of elevated water levels that inundate the bridge. During high canal flows, Norwood Avenue had to be closed by using stop log floodwalls. This project will eliminate the need for road closure during high canal flows by raising the bridge.
- C. The Project is funded by Federal Highway Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation (HBRR) Program Funds. Under this program, the federal government pays 88.53% of the cost the project, while the City pays an 11.47% local match.
- D. In June 2007, City approved contract awarded for an amount of \$943,766 to T.Y. Lin International (T.Y. Lin) to design the Project. The structural section of the bridge was changed from a box girder to a slab section to satisfy hydraulic requirements. Supplemental agreements with a total amount increase of \$92,461 were issued to compensate T. Y. Lin for changes to the scope of services and additional design. The supplemental agreements were approved under the City's Manager's administrative authority. Additional funds are needed to complete design and right of way.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The FY10/11 Capital Improvement Program Budget is amended by transferring \$100,000 (Fund 2007) from the Major Street Improvement Project (T15118000) to the Norwood Avenue Bridge Replacement Project (T15068400).
- Section 2. The City Manager's administrative authority is reset for the professional services agreement with T.Y. Lin International.
- Section 3. Exhibit A is incorporated into and made part of this Resolution.


Location map for:

NORTHERN CALIFORNIA REGIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY TRAINING COLLEGE – JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY, FY2010/11 ANNUAL BUDGET

BACKGROUND

- A. The Northern California Regional Public Safety Training College (NCRPSTC) was established in 2001 at McClellan Business Park through a Joint Powers Authority (JPA).
- B. On August 14, 2001, the City Council approved Resolution #2001-571 authorizing the formation and execution of a Joint Powers Agreement (#2001-137). The Resolution and Agreement require that member agencies approve the annual JPA budget prior to allocating funds to the JPA.
- C. The JPA membership agencies include the County of Sacramento, the City of Sacramento, the California Regional Fire and Rescue Training Authority, and the Los Rios Community College District

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to approve the Annual Northern California Regional Public Safety Training College (NCRPSTC) – Joint Powers Authority (JPA) FY2010/11 Budget, in the total amount of \$7,743,950.
- Section 2. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to approve a payment of \$225,726 to the JPA for the use of rental space at the JPA campus facility.




