

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-666

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

November 23, 2010

APPROVING ELK GROVE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT SUBCONTRACT AGREEMENTS

BACKGROUND

- A. The Department of Parks and Recreation has operated the START (Students Today Achieving Results for Tomorrow) after-school literacy and enrichment program since 1996.
- B. The City has operated the START program at John Reith and Isabelle Jackson elementary schools in the Elk Grove Unified School District (Elk Grove) as a direct grant recipient from the California Department of Education (CDE) for many years.
- C. Elk Grove is now the direct grant recipient from CDE for the after-school program at John Reith and Isabelle Jackson. Elk Grove has requested that the City operate the START program at these two school sites on a subcontract basis. Elk Grove will pay the City's full direct costs of operating the programs, up to a total of \$279,205 in Fiscal Year (FY) 2010/11.
- D. No additional or General Fund appropriation is required.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute two subcontract agreements and any extensions, amendments, or other related documents with the Elk Grove Unified School District (Elk Grove) as necessary for the City to be an after-school program subcontractor to Elk Grove at John Reith and Isabelle Jackson Elementary Schools and be reimbursed by Elk Grove up to \$279,205 in Fiscal Year (FY) 2010/11.
- Section 2. The City Manager or designee is authorized to adjust the operating revenue and expenditure budgets as necessary to implement the agreements.
- Section 3. The agreements described in Section 1 are attached as Exhibit A and Exhibit B and made a part of this Resolution.


