Description/Analysis

Issue: Under City Agreement No. 2009-0670, SCS Engineers provides general engineering technical support services for the City’s Dellar Landfill, the 28th Street Landfill and Old Elvas Landfill. The agreement is set to expire on July 31, 2011. Staff recommends an extension of this agreement for an additional three years to July 31, 2014 and an increase of the not to exceed amount from \$233,500 to \$685,355, and extend the agreement term to July 31, 2014.

Extending the agreement is necessary for the City to comply with new greenhouse gas regulations adopted by the California Air Resources Board (“ARB”) to be effective January 2011. The new regulations require more frequent and detailed surface monitoring of the methane gas field on the 28th Street Landfill, therefore increasing the annual cost; and

Policy Considerations: Pursuant to Section 3.64.020(B) of the City Code, Council approval is required for any supplemental agreement that increases the agreement amount by more than \$100,000.

Environmental Considerations:

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA): The services covered by this agreement support ongoing administrative and maintenance activities that do not constitute a “project” so that no CEQA review is required to approve the agreement (CEQA Guidelines § 15378(b)(2)).

Sustainability Considerations: Approval of the supplemental agreement will support the City’s Sustainability Master Plan by ensuring the reduction of greenhouse gas production by methane gas generated at the 28th Street Landfill.

Commission/Committee Action: None

Rationale for Recommendation: At the time City Agreement No. 2009-0670 with SCS Engineers was approved, the current greenhouse gas regulations were still being developed. The greenhouse gas regulations have been adopted by the California Air Resource Board and will be implemented in January 2011. The greenhouse gas regulations require more frequent and detailed monitoring of the methane gas collection system and landfill cap, therefore increasing cost.

Financial Considerations: The total dollar amount for the agreement will increase by \$451,855 for a total not to exceed dollar amount of \$685,355. Sufficient funding exists in the Solid Waste Fund (6007) operating budget to award the supplemental agreement.

Emerging Small Business Development (ESBD): Not applicable

BACKGROUND

SCS Engineers provides landfill general engineering technical support services for the 28th Street Landfill, Old Elvas Landfill and the Dellar Landfill. The scope of services includes an annual flare test and surface emissions test for the 28th Street Landfill, providing on-call engineering and O&M services for the 28th Street Landfill and Old Elvas Landfill, and selected regulatory and engineering support for the Dellar Landfill property. City staff conducts the majority of the regulatory monitoring and reporting and SCS Engineers provides specialty services not available through City staff, including specific tasks, to meet federal and state requirements. California Air Resources Board (ARB) Greenhouse Gas Regulations:

In 2006, the state Legislature enacted the California Global Warming Solutions Act of 2006 (AB 32) to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions in the state, with the overall goal of restoring emissions to 1990 levels by the year 2020. AB 32 requires ARB to adopt regulations to implement the measures identified on the list of Discrete Early Action Measures. In June 2007, ARB identified reducing methane gas emissions from municipal solid waste (MSW) landfills as a discrete early action measure.

The newly adopted greenhouse gas regulations changed the requirements for how surface emissions monitoring are conducted and increased monitoring frequency from once a year to four times per year to ensure that gas collection and control systems are operating optimally and that methane emissions are minimized. The requirements are summarized below.

- Quarterly instantaneous surface emissions monitoring (SEM) at 25-foot spacing with a 500 parts per million volume (ppmv) methane limit, including testing of cover penetrations, with corrective action/re-monitoring.
- Quarterly leak testing of landfill gas (LFG) collection and control system (GCCS) components not under vacuum at a 500 ppmv methane limit, including corrective action/re-monitoring.
- Quarterly integrated surface sampling with a limit of 25 ppmv methane.
- Test methods and procedures for how to conduct SEM.

The 28th Street Landfill is subject to the new green house gas regulations. The Solid Waste Division had the last surface emissions test for the 28th Street Landfill completed in the fall of 2009 in compliance with the draft green house gas regulations. The test was done by SCS Engineers as part of the current agreement. The emissions test completed at that time showed the 28th Street Landfill will meet the new regulations; therefore the additional cost projections in the revised budget are expected to be a worst case scenario in the event the 28th Street Landfill fails to meet the new regulations. The actual costs are expected to be lower.

SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 1 WITH SCS ENGINEERS FOR LANDFILL GENERAL ENGINEERING TECHNICAL SUPPORT SERVICES

BACKGROUND

- A. In July 2009, City entered into an agreement with SCS Engineers for general engineering technical support services for the 28th Street Landfill, Dellar Landfill and Old Elvas Landfill (City Agreement No. 2009-0670). The agreement with SCS Engineers expires in July 2011.
- B. The California Air Resources Board recently adopted new greenhouse gas regulations to reduce methane emissions from municipal solid waste landfills, to be effective January 1, 2011. Title 17 of the California Code of Regulations sections 95460 to 95476 changed the requirements for how to conduct surface emissions monitoring and increased the monitoring frequency from once a year to four times per year. The 28th Street Landfill is subject to the newly adopted regulations.
- C. Because the new greenhouse regulations require more frequent and detailed monitoring of the methane gas collection system and landfill cap, therefore increasing the annual cost, staff recommends extending the agreement with SCS in order to comply with the new regulations.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to City Agreement No. 2009-0670 with SCS Engineers for general engineering technical support services for the 28th Street Landfill, Dellar Landfill and Old Elvas Landfill, for an amount not to exceed \$451,855 and to extend the agreement term to July 31, 2014.



Unexecuted Contract/Agreements

- The Unexecuted Contract/Agreement is signed by the other party, is attached as an exhibit to the resolution, and is approved as to form by the City Attorney.

- The Unexecuted Contract is NOT included as an exhibit to the resolution because, due to special circumstances, and the City Attorney confirms in writing that it is okay to proceed with Council action even though the signed agreement is not in hand yet.

The City of Sacramento ("City") and **SCS ENGINEERS** ("Contractor"), as parties to that certain Professional Services Agreement designated as Agreement Number 2009-0670, including any and all prior supplemental agreements modifying said agreement (said agreement and supplemental agreements are hereafter collectively referred to as the "Agreement"), hereby supplement and modify the Agreement as follows:

1. The scope of Services specified in Attachment 1 to Exhibit A of the Agreement is deleted and replaced in its entirety with Attachment 1-A to Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
2. The Time of Performance specified in Exhibit A of the Agreement is amended as follows:


5. Time of Performance. The services described herein shall be from the date the agreement is approved by City Council through July 31, 2014.

3. Attachment 1 to Exhibit B of the Agreement is deleted and replaced in its entirety with Attachment 1-A to Exhibit B, attached hereto and incorporated by reference.
4. In consideration of the additional and/or revised services described in sections 1 and 2 above, the maximum not-to-exceed amount that is specified in Exhibit B of the Agreement for payment of Contractor's fees and expenses, is **increased by \$451,855**, and said maximum not-to-exceed amount is amended as follows:

Agreement's original not-to-exceed amount:	<u>\$233,500.00</u>
Net change by previous supplemental agreements:	<u>\$0.00</u>
Not-to-exceed amount prior to this supplemental agreement:	<u>\$233,500.00</u>
Increase by this supplemental agreement:	<u>\$451,855.00</u>
New not-to exceed amount including all supplemental agreements:	<u>\$685,355.00</u>

5. Contractor agrees that the amount of increase or decrease in the not-to-exceed amount specified in section 2, above, shall constitute full compensation for the additional and/or revised services specified in section 1, above, and shall fully compensate Contractor for any and all direct and indirect costs that may be incurred by Contractor in connection with such additional and/or revised services, including costs associated with any changes and/or delays in work schedules or in the performance of other services or work by Contractor.
6. Contractor warrants and represents that the person or persons executing this supplemental agreement on behalf of Contractor has or have been duly authorized by Contractor to sign this supplemental agreement and bind Contractor to the terms hereof.
7. Except as specifically revised herein, all terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect, and Contractor shall perform all of the services, duties, obligations, and conditions required under the Agreement, as supplemented and modified by this supplemental agreement.

EXHIBIT A, ATTACHMENT 1-A

General Engineering Support for Dellar, 28th Street and Old Elvas Landfills.

TASK 1: Surface Emissions Plan and Monitoring

- A) Prepare and submit the LFG Heat Input Capacity Report to the California Air Resources Board (CARB) by September 15, 2010.
- B) Prepare and submit the Surface Emissions Monitoring (SEM) to the CARB in 2010.
- C) Complete quarterly SEM pursuant to the Green House Gas(GHG) Regulations.-14 Quarters
- D) Request an alternative plan for SEM in the event the 28th Street Landfill does not meet the requirements of GHG Regulations.

TASK 2: Quarterly SEM /Leak Testing for GHG Regulatory Compliance.-15 Quarters.

- A) Complete Surface Emissions Monitoring and Leak tests pursuant to GHG regulations.
- B) Prepare and submit draft written report to the City within 30-days of Surface Emissions Monitoring completed.

TASK 3: AB 32 LMR Annual Report Prepared and Submitted to California Air Resources Board Starting 2012.

TASK 4: Prepare and Submit EPA Green House Gas Annual Reports starting 2011 through 2014.

Prepare the annual report required under EPA GHG reporting rule for submittal to EPA. Draft documents will be delivered to the City for review and revisions made per City direction. A total of four reports will be prepared.

TASK 5: Non Routine Re-Monitoring.

If required, SCS shall perform any re-testing/monitoring required on a time and materials basis in accordance with the contract fee schedule.

TASK 6: Flare Test:

SCS shall conduct annual source testing of one or both flares at the 28th Street Landfill in accordance with the site's Title V Permit and applicable rules and regulations. The following sub-tasks shall be completed as part of Task 6:

- A) Obtain competitive qualifications and pricing from source testing contractors, if requested.
- B) SCS will select the sub-contractor to perform the flare test.

- C) Prepare and submit the Source Test protocol to the Sacramento Metropolitan AQMD (SMAQMD).
- D) Complete proper notifications to the SMAQMD.
- E) Arrange for and schedule source testing with City and sub contractor. Ensure all necessary equipment is available on-site.
- F) Complete pre-testing analysis of flares prior to actual testing, if necessary.
- G) Complete full source testing of each flare.

TASK 7: Review LFG and Air Quality Data for 28th Street Landfill and Old Elvas Landfill.

This task is upon request by the City and may include the following:

- A) Evaluate LFG monitoring data and air data and recommend strategies for controlling LFG migration and addressing exceedances.
- B) Provide as-needed assistance to City for reduction in operation of the Old Elvas migration control system.
- C) Provide miscellaneous air and LFG permitting and compliance services.
- D) Apply for less than continuous operation or exemption for LFG system at Old Elvas Landfill.

TASK 8: Provide Services for Cover and Drainage for 28th Street Landfill.

Upon request SCS will provide design services for any needed improvements to the cover, drainage and other containment features at the 28th Street Landfill.

If needed, SCS will submit a work plan and budget to complete the requested work.

TASK 9: Assist with RWQCB Compliance for the 28th Street and/or the Old Elvas Landfills.

Upon request by the City, SCS will provide support for compliance with the Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB), including:

- A) Review RWQCB correspondence and recommend/draft response.
- B) Evaluate existing data to determine compliance with RWQCB Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) or other compliance orders.
- C) Assist with negotiations between the City and RWQCB for new or revised WDRs or other compliance orders.
- D) Provide third party review of compliance documents prepared by the City or others.
- E) Prepare non-routine documents to be submitted to RWQCB for special studies, evaluations, work plans, or installation reports.
- F) Prepare draft requests for proposals for groundwater/subsurface investigation contractors such as drillers or geophysicists.
- G) Provide oversight for investigation activities.

- H) Recommend to the city any changes existing monitoring programs to make them more cost-effective and compliant with regulations and orders.
- I) Review applicable local, state and federal regulations to determine compliance status.

TASK 10: Assist with RWQCB for Dellar Landfill.

The work under this task is as needed and may include:

- A) Review RWQCB correspondence and recommend/draft responses.
- B) Evaluate existing data to determine compliance with RWQCB WDRs or other compliance orders.
- C) Assist with negotiations between the City and RWQCB for new or revised WDRs or other compliance orders.
- D) Provide third party review of compliance documents prepared by the City or others.
- E) Prepare draft requests for proposals for groundwater/subsurface investigation contractors such as drillers or geophysicists.
- F) Provide oversight for investigation activities.
- G) Recommend to the City any changes in existing monitoring programs to make them more cost effective and compliant with regulations and orders.
- H) Review applicable local, state and federal regulations to determine compliance status.
- I) Conduct as needed engineering tasks related to Dellar closure.

Task 11: Regulatory Review.

Upon request, SCS will meet with staff to discuss and review current and/or proposed regulations and the impact on environmental monitoring procedures and cost to implement.


