

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-714

AUTHORIZING AMENDING THE SPENDING PLAN FOR THE 2009 FEDERAL ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND CONSERVATION BLOCK GRANT

BACKGROUND

- A. The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 appropriated \$3.2 billion for the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) Program, most of which (over \$2.7 billion) was distributed through formula grants on a per capita basis. The City was awarded \$4.7 million in EECBG funds in 2009.
- B. The City's spending plan for the 2009 Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant identifies the dollar amounts allocated to various Federal Energy Efficiency Grant Projects and Federal Energy Efficiency Capital Improvement Projects.
- C. The current amount allocated for the preparation of the Climate Action Plan is \$250,000.
- D. Additional funds are required to complete the development of the Climate Action Plan and to expand Climate Action Plan Activities to include reporting and 3rd party certification of greenhouse gas emissions from municipal operations for 2007, 2008, and 2009.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The spending plan for the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant funding is amended as set forth in Section 2 below.
- Section 2. EECBG funds in the amount of \$109,188 are hereby reprogrammed from the Regional Assessment Financing Program (G13000054, Fund 2702) to the Climate Action Plan (G13000051, Fund 2702).


