

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2011-040**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

### **AGREEMENT: FY09 INTEROPERABLE EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS GRANT PROGRAM**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. Resolution #2010-536 approved the acceptance of \$210,000 in grant funding for the FY09 Interoperable Emergency Communications Grant Program (IECGP) from the State of California, Emergency Management Agency, sub-granted through the City and County of San Francisco. The first priority of the grant is to bridge gaps in leadership, governance and common operational planning and protocols. To that end, the Sacramento Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) is coordinating a joint project with San Francisco Bay Area UASI to formalize interoperable communications governance between the two regions.
- B. A Request for Proposals (RFP) was issued on October 29, 2010. Four proposals were received. The evaluation committee read and scored the technical section of the proposals, tallied the individual scores, and ranked the proposals. Based on criteria specified in the RFP, the evaluation committee concluded that Willdan Homeland Solutions was the leading consultant and will be able to meet the needs and requirements of the project. Therefore, staff is recommending Willdan Homeland Solutions as the consultant to develop a governance structure related to interoperable communications for the Capital and Bay Areas.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The Interim City Manager, or the Interim City Manager's designee, is authorized to execute a professional services agreement with Willdan Homeland Solutions for the implementation of the Capital-Bay Interoperable Communications Governance Project in an amount not to exceed \$157,365.00.


