Description/Analysis

Issue: Provide notice to the City Council of the intent of the City Clerk to conduct an election among active members of the Sacramento City Employees Retirement System to fill one seat on the Retirement Hearing Commission.

Policy Considerations: The notification and election process is consistent with the procedures adopted by Resolution 2011-024.

Rationale for Recommendation: Conduct an election to fill a seat that is vacant on the Retirement Hearing Commission.

Background:

The Retirement Hearing Commission hears issues and appeals relating to the City of Sacramento Employees Retirement System (SCERS). The Commission seats five members, two of which are required to be elected by active members of SCERS. The procedure for conducting this type of election is outlined in Resolution 2011-024. As required by the Resolution, the City Council is being advised of the intent to hold an election due to one vacancy.

If more than one candidate qualifies, an election will be held. If only one candidate qualifies, then that candidate shall be deemed automatically elected by the City Clerk. A tentative election is scheduled for April 18, 2011 and will be conducted by mail ballot. If an election is held the candidate who receives the highest number of votes cast will be declared elected. As required by the election procedures, the City Clerk will notify the City Council of the results.
