

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2011-090**

### **ADOPT THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING TO FUND OPERATION AT THE COMPREHENSIVE ALCOHOL TREATMENT CENTER**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. In 1997 the City Council approved Resolution 2007-447, an agreement between the City and the County of Sacramento Department of Human Assistance establishing the cooperative efforts to provide a comprehensive alcohol treatment center.
- B. A collaborative partnership exists to fund and operate the Comprehensive Alcohol Treatment Center which includes: the Downtown Partnership, the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency, Volunteers of America, the County of Sacramento and the City of Sacramento.
- C. The Comprehensive Alcohol Treatment Center is part of the Community Prosecution Pilot Program in the downtown area and one of the programs in the Ten-Year Plan to End Chronic Homelessness.
- D. The City's contribution to the Comprehensive Alcohol Treatment Center for fiscal year 2010/2011 will not exceed \$708,351.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1     The Interim City Manager is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the Sacramento County to fund operations at the Comprehensive Alcohol Treatment Center for Fiscal Year 2010/2011.

Section 2 The City's contribution to the Comprehensive Alcohol Treatment Center for Fiscal Year 2010/2011 will not exceed \$708,351 included in the approved budget for Fiscal Year 2010/2011.

Section 3 The memorandum of understanding identified in section 1 is attached as exhibit A and is part of this resolution.


