

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2011-113**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

March 1, 2011

### **AMENDING THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO TO DELETE THE REDEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEES AND CORRESPONDING DISCLOSURE CATEGORY**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The City Council has adopted and promulgated a conflict of interest code for the City of Sacramento as required by the Political Reform Act, Government Code section 81000 et seq.;
- B. The City's conflict of interest code designates membership on a redevelopment advisory committee ("RAC") as a position which must file a statement of economic interests;
- C. The Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento ("Agency") was involved in the formation of each of the RACs identified in the City's conflict of interest code, and the RACs provide advice primarily to the Agency;
- D. Given the relationship between the RACs and the Agency, the City Council has determined that RAC members should be included in the Agency's conflict of interest code rather than the City's conflict of interest code, and that the City's conflict of interest code should be amended to effect this change;
- E. The Agency is concurrently amending its conflict of interest code to add membership on a RAC as a position that is required to file a statement of economic interests with the Agency.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City of Sacramento's conflict of interest code, adopted by Resolution 2010-071, is amended to delete the following positions from Appendix A: 65th Street Redevelopment Advisory Committee, Alkali Flat Redevelopment Advisory Committee, Del Paso Heights Redevelopment Advisory Committee, North Sacramento Redevelopment Advisory Committee, Oak Park Redevelopment Advisory Committee, Sacramento Army Depot Redevelopment Advisory Committee, and Stockton Boulevard Redevelopment Advisory Committee.

Section 2. The City of Sacramento's conflict of interest code, adopted by Resolution 2010-071, is amended to delete Disclosure Category 18 ("All investments and business positions in business entities, and income from sources, that do business with the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency or any of the entities administered by the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency") from Exhibit B.

Section 3. This resolution takes effect on the date it is passed, and each person who occupied a position that was deleted from the City's conflict of interest code on the effective date of this resolution shall file a leaving office statement with the City Clerk within 30 days of the effective date of this resolution.


