

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-126

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

March 8, 2011

APPROVING SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION UNDER THE WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACT (WIA) FOR THE YOUTH EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING PROGRAM

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento's Parks and Recreation Department has operated the Youth Employment and Training Program under the Job Training Partnership Act, funded locally through the SETA since 1989. In 2000, the United States Department of Labor replaced the Job Training Partnership Act with the Workforce Investment Act (W.I.A.).
- B. The WIA Youth Employment program is a year-round program that requires agencies to provide work experience linked to academic learning, secondary school completion services, leadership development opportunities, adult mentors, comprehensive guidance and counseling, supportive services, and follow-up services for a minimum of twelve months after the youth leaves the program. The Department of Labor is investing money in youth in order to provide the services required for the youth to successfully transition into non-subsidized work to complete high school.
- C. The WIA grant requires a fifty-percent match, which is funded through the City's support for the Youth Employment program under the Parks and Recreation Department's Teen Services Section.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to submit a grant application for a total amount not to exceed \$300,000 annually for the next five years (FY 2012-2016) to the Sacramento Employment and Training Agency (SETA) and the Sacramento Works Youth Council (SWYC) to provide funding to continue the Youth Employment Program under the Workforce Investment Act (WIA).
- Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute all agreements and documents necessary to accept the grant funds, and establish a grant project and related revenue and expenditure budgets for the grant funds contingent on receipt of grant awards.


