**RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2010-283 AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE OF THE ALLEYWAY BOUNDED BY FOLSOM BOULEVARD, 36TH, 37TH AND M STREETS
PROCEEDING NO. TSC10-02**

BACKGROUND

- A. California Vehicle Code Section 21101.4 and Sacramento City Code Chapter 12.16 authorize the City to close a street or alley to "through" traffic.
- B. Pursuant to the authority granted to the city pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 21101.4 and City Code Chapter 12.16, on May 25, 2010, the City Council adopted Resolution 2010-283 temporarily closing the alley bounded by Folsom Boulevard, 36th, 37th and M Streets.
- C. Through inadvertence, subsection 4(c), which requires access to all pedestrians and vehicles, not only local pedestrians and vehicles, was inadvertently included by staff in Resolution 2010-283. Subsection 4(c) should not be included in the resolution.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection 4(c) is deleted from Resolution 2010-283.
