CONTRACT AWARD OF STRAWBERRY MANOR METER RETROFIT PROJECT (Z14010055)

BACKGROUND

- A. The purpose of this project is to retrofit approximately 1,043 existing residential and commercial water service connections with a water meter to comply with state Assembly Bill 2572, which requires all water service connections be metered by 2025.
- B. City staff prepared plans and specifications to install 1,043 meter retrofits in the Strawberry Manor Meter Retrofit project limits.
- C. The Strawberry Manor Meter Retrofit Project was advertised for bidding and eleven bids were received on March 3, 2011. The lowest responsible bidder was Florez Paving.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The contract specifications for the Strawberry Manor Meter Retrofit Project (Z14010055) are approved, and the contract is awarded to Florez Paving for an amount not to exceed \$960,710.


