WHEREAS, the health, safety, welfare and quality of life of the City of Sacramento residents greatly depends on these services; and


WHEREAS, the quality and effectiveness of these services, as well as their planning, design, and construction is vitally dependent upon the efforts and skills of public works employees; and






STEVE COHN, DISTRICT 3








