Description/Analysis

Issue: With this action, the City Council will amend the conflict of interest code to add new classifications and amend language to comply with the filing requirements of public officials who manage public investments.

Policy Considerations: Updating the conflict of interest code fulfills the City's obligation under the Political Reform Act to update its conflict of interest Code to reflect changed circumstances.

Environmental Considerations: None.

Rationale for Recommendation: Pursuant to Government Code § 81000, et seq., local agencies are required to update their conflict of interest codes to reflect changed circumstances relating to its designated filers and disclosure categories.

Background:

Since the City of Sacramento adopted its conflict of interest code in February of 2010, new job classifications have been created and there have been other changes in circumstances that require the City to update the conflict of interest code. The changes include how public officials who manage public investments are classified under the conflict of interest code, inclusion of several new classifications, and adding existing classifications that have been recently identified as having decision making authority.

AMENDING THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO

BACKGROUND:

- A. As required by Government Code section 87300, the City of Sacramento has adopted and promulgated a conflict of interest code; and
- B. On February 16, 2010, the City Council of the City of Sacramento adopted Resolution 2010-071, which adopted a revised conflict of interest code for the City of Sacramento; and
- C. The City Council of the City of Sacramento has determined that because of changed circumstances it should amend the City's conflict of interest code.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The City of Sacramento's conflict of interest code, adopted by Resolution 2010-071, is amended as follows:

Section 1. Add Section 650 to Exhibit A to read as follows:

SECTION 650. Positions that manage public investments for the purposes of Government Code section 87200 include: (a) the members of the Administration, Investment and Fiscal Management Board and (b) the following positions in the City Treasurer's Office: (1) Chief Investment Officer and (2) Senior Investment Officer. These officials shall file their statements of economic interest with the City Clerk.

Section 2. Add the following classifications and corresponding disclosure categories to Appendix 2:

Office of the City Auditor – Add the classification of Auditor; disclosure categories 1, 2, 3, and 4.

Mayor/Council Office - Add the classification Chief Service Officer; disclosure categories 1, 2, 3, and 4.

Utilities - Add the classifications: a) Construction Inspector II; disclosure categories 4, 5, 9, 11, and 29; b) Construction Inspector II; disclosure categories 4, 5, 9, 11, and 29; and, c) Supervising Construction Inspector; disclosure categories 4, 5, 9, 1 and, 29.

City Manager's Office – Add the classification of Deputy City Manager; disclosure categories 1, 2, 3, and 4.

Section 3. Delete the following classifications from Appendix 2:

City Treasurer's Office – Chief Investment Officer and Senior Investment Officer.

Administration, Investment and Fiscal Management Board

Section 4. This resolution will take effect on the date it is passed, and each person who occupies a position that was added to the conflict of interest code shall file an assuming office statement with the City Clerk within 30 days of the effective date of this resolution. For persons who occupy a position that was added, but has already filed an initial office statement with the City Clerk, shall continue to file statements in accordance with conflict of interest code.
