

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-278

AWARD CONTRACT FOR 26TH AVENUE SEWER REPLACEMENT, 24TH TO 25TH ST (X14010057)

BACKGROUND

- A. The sewer pipeline in 26th Avenue between 24th and 25th Streets is in poor condition and in need of replacement.
- B. City staff prepared plans and specifications for the 26th Avenue Sewer Replacement, 24th to 25th Street project, to replace approximately 630 linear feet of sewer pipeline, including sewer services, drain inlets and manholes. The project was advertised and eleven bids were received on April 13, 2011.
- C. Navajo Pipelines Inc. was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.
- D. The estimated cost for the 26th Avenue Sewer Replacement Project (X14010057) is \$218,000. The current project budget is \$175,000. There are sufficient storm drainage funds in the Base CIP Reserve (W14000200) to transfer \$43,000 to upgrade the drain inlets for the project.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to transfer \$43,000 from the Storm Drainage Fund 6011 Base CIP Reserve (W14000200) to the 26th Avenue Sewer Replacement Project (X14010057) to provide funding to the project to upgrade the drain inlets.
- Section 2. The plans and specifications for the 26th Avenue Sewer Replacement, 24th to 25th St Contract (X14010057) are approved, and the contract is awarded to Navajo Pipelines Inc, for an amount not to exceed \$129,916.25.


