

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2011-325**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

June 7, 2011

### **D/E ALLEY SEWER REPLACEMENT, 12<sup>TH</sup> TO 13<sup>TH</sup> STREET**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. This alley sewer improvement project will replace the existing combined sewer pipe with a larger pipe, designed to convey flows from the La Valentina development and surrounding area. The project will renew the effective life of the aging combined sewer pipeline located in the alley between D and E Street, from 12<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> Street.
- B. The project will be funded in part with Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Recovery Act funds. An individual Project Agreement (Award # B-09-MY-06-0003, City Agreement 2001-0224-279) with SHRA was executed on March 1, 2011.
- C. Funding in the total amount of \$45,000 is available from the Base CIP Reserves (X14000500, Fund 6006 and W14000200, Fund 6011) for the additional costs of the D/E Alley Sewer Replacement, 12<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> Street project.
- D. City staff prepared the plans and contract specifications to replace approximately 424 linear feet of sewer pipeline, including sewer services, drain inlets and manholes. The project was advertised and nine (9) bids were received on May 4, 2011.
- E. Florez Paving was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to establish revenue and expenditure budgets in the amount of \$165,000 in the CSS Miscellaneous Project (X14010000) in a reimbursable Fund 3702.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to transfer \$22,500 from the Base CIP Reserve Sewer (X14000500, Fund 6006) and \$22,500 from Base CIP Reserve Drainage (W14000200, Fund 6011) to the CSS Miscellaneous Project (X14010000).
- Section 3. The contract plans and specifications for the D/E Alley Sewer Replacement, 12<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> Street project are approved, and the contract is awarded to Florez Paving, for an amount not to exceed \$99,185.55.


