APPROVAL OF SACRAMENTO EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING AGENCY (SETA) TO RECEIVE FUNDS FROM THE EMPLOYER COMMUNITY AND PUBLIC TO SUPPORT SACRAMENTO WORKS, INC. ACTIVITIES

BACKGROUND

- A. The Sacramento Employment and Training Agency (SETA) Governing Board has approved actions that require the review and approval of the Sacramento City Council.
- B. Under the Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement, SETA is required to request authority from the Partners (City of Sacramento and County of Sacramento) to accept any form of financial assistance not specifically identified in the Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement.
- C. The Sacramento Metropolitan Utilities District (SMUD) and other employers desire to provide resources to SETA to provide a fee-for-service program to recruit, assess, and place entry-level employees at employer sites.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Approves SETA receiving funds from the employer community and general public to support employment opportunities for adult and youth job seekers.


