

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2011-388**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

June 21, 2011

### **CONFIRMING DIAGRAM AND ASSESSMENT AND LEVYING ASSESSMENT FOR THE CITYWIDE LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 2 FOR FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2011/12**

#### **BACKGROUND:**

- A.** The Citywide Landscaping and Lighting Assessment District No. 2 (District), was established by the City Council (Council) on August 1, 1989. The Council adopted Resolution No. 89-600 thereby approving Assessment District No. 2 for all developed properties within the City of Sacramento.
- B.** The Council established the District under the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 (Part 2 of Division 15 in the Streets and Highways Code, beginning with Section 22500) (the 1972 Act), and has previously levied assessments on property in the District to pay for landscaping and lighting maintenance services and related services to be provided within the District, all in accordance with the 1972 Act.
- C.** Pursuant to Chapter 3 of the 1972 Act, Council directed the Supervising Engineer of the Department of Transportation, as the Engineer of Work for the District, to prepare and file an Annual Report for FY2011/12.
- D.** The Engineer of Work filed the Annual Report on May 31, 2011, and Council adopted the Resolution approving the Engineer's Annual Report and Intention to levy and collect assessments within the assessment district for FY2011/12 and set a public hearing for June 21, 2011, in the meeting place of Council, City Hall, 915 I Street, First Floor, Sacramento, California. Notice of the hearing was given in the time and manner required by law.
- E.** The FY2011/12 assessments are increased by the change between the April 2011 and the April 2010 Consumer Price Index, and equal to the highest authorized amount for the District shown on Exhibit A.
- F.** The Council is fully advised in this matter.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL  
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The City Council:

- a) Confirms the assessment diagram and the assessment roll set forth in the Engineer's Annual Report on file with the Public Improvement Financing unit of the Finance Department, designated by the City Clerk to be the repository of documents associated with special districts and approved by City Council on May 31, 2011; and;
- b) Levies the assessment set forth in the Engineer's Annual Report.

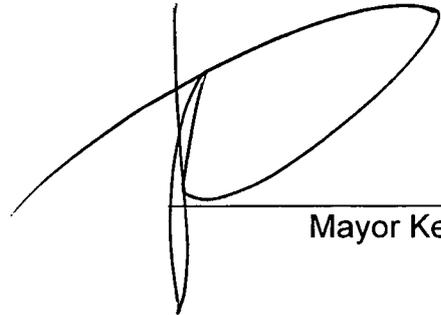
